

Winter Driving Course Requirements

- Driver must have a valid driver's license or DMV certified permit with at least one BTW instruction. (Subject to refusal if I deem them not ready to drive in snow. No refund so let's discuss beforehand)
- Driver must not have ingested any alcohol, drugs (including over-the-counter or prescribed) that would impair driving within the past 12 hours of your lesson.
- Driver does not suffer from any condition including but not limited to, epilepsy, hearing or visual impairment which would render their driving unreasonably dangerous and will wear (if prescribed) any eyewear or hearing apparatus required to safely and properly operate a motor vehicle.
- Driver must be in a safe frame of mind regardless of the source of impairment.
- Proof of current Insurance and Registration
- Vehicle must be in safe working condition for winter adverse conditions.
 - It is up to me to determine if your vehicle is safe. If you in doubt, you must arrange for me to inspect your vehicle 72 hours before your lesson. No charge for inspection, but no refund if you skip the inspection and I later deem it unsafe. This is for YOUR and MY safety!
 - 4wd or AWD only. Possible exceptions if chains or studded approved tires installed. (See next bullet)
 - Tires must have the mountain/snowflake symbol on the tire. M+S (mud + snow) tires must be studded or chains pre-installed. Sorry, NO EXCEPTIONS.



- All lights must be working (Brake, Signal, Emergency, Headlights)
- Working windshield wipers, front & rear defrosters, and rear-facing mirrors.
- ABS equipped and working. This light should light up at start and turn off when engine running.
